#### **HOW TO REGISTER:**

#### Online (the quickest option!):

To register for a vaccine, please click the link below and follow instructions for scheduling an appointment. DenverHealth.org/patients-visitors/coronavirus/covid-19-vaccination.

If you do not have a MyChart account, you will need to create one. Please use your personal email to create your mychart account. Once in MyChart you will be able to schedule your vaccine appointment.

### By Phone:

If you don't have access to MyChart, you can schedule an appointment by calling **303-602-8958**. Please listen to all options. Phone wait times may be long, but we want to help get your vaccine appointment scheduled as soon as possible. You can also call your local SBHC to schedule your vaccine appointment.

**REMEMBER:** If you are under 18, you need to get parental consent to get vaccinated. Please make sure your parent fills out a consent form and you bring it with you to the vaccine appointment. Children under the age of 11 must have a parent present at time of vaccination. Click <a href="here">here</a> to download the consent for treatment form.

#### What we want you to know about the COVID-19 vaccine:

- . The COVID-19 vaccine is safe for youth ages 5+
- The COVID-19 vaccine has been shown to be very good at preventing people from getting COVID disease
- People may have some side effects after the vaccine. These are normal signs that your body is building protection and only lasts a few days.
