2022-2023 PARKING REGISTRATION

To Students and Families:

Denver Public Schools allows students to use designated student parking areas only with the approval of the school operations team.

In order to use the parking lot, students **MUST** have a **FUSION** parking permit that is **placed in a corner of the windshield** (information side facing out) of the vehicle. The parking permit must be renewed yearly and is good only for the registered motor vehicle for which it is purchased. All vehicles are to be locked. **THE SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ITEMS STOLEN, OR ANY DAMAGE DONE TO A VEHICLE WHILE THE VEHICLE IS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY.**

Parking permits are issued by the school and are subject to denial or can be withdrawn for violations of safety, school or county regulations. Citations will be issued for improper parking or other minor violation for 1st time offenses. Additional violations can result in revoking permit and/or the permit shall be revoked if:

- 1) A student is habitually tardy.
- 2) Using the vehicle to skip school or leave campus without authorization.
- 3) Taking or picking up others off campus during school hours.
- 4) Violates safe driving regulations or laws of the state.
- 5) The permit may be revoked or suspended for other reasons, as the school administration is the final judge in issuing permits.
- 6) The loss of privileges due to suspension may **REVOKE PARKING PRIVILEGES.**

To register for a parking permit you must bring the following:

- Parent permission form signed by parents (back of this letter)*
- Student signed parking agreement (back of this letter)*
- Valid Driver's License (Photo Copy)
- Proof of Insurance (Photo Copy)
- Current Registration of Vehicle (Photo Copy)
- **Pay \$25.00.**

Parking spots are limited. There are 120 total parking spots, 60 for each school. Please see your school's main office for specific details on how parking permits are sold.

STUDENT PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION 2022-2023

REGULATIONS:

- All students must have a parking permit to park in the designated student parking lot.
- Permits are available for \$25 per year, and are non transferable.
- Permits must *be placed on the front windshield* (information side facing out).
- Permits are good only for the registered motor vehicle for which purchased.
- Students must follow specific entrance and exit directions.
- The provisions of these rules shall apply equally to all registered motor vehicles.
- *No student shall loiter in or around the parking areas.*
- ***Students are not permitted to go to vehicles during the school day. The vehicle will not be used as a locker.***
- Student shall not occupy vehicles during class hours, between class and before or after school except as they arrive and leave for the school day.
- The driver of the vehicle shall be responsible that any student being transported off campus by him has proper authorization.
- Vehicles parked on the Regis Groff property or designed student parking sites are subject to search by school officials.

I have read and understand the parking regulations on both sides of this application, which include my parent's permission and signature. I agree to follow the rules and understand that violating these rules, including parking in the proper space, could result in a fine and/or a discipline referral. Failure to pay a fine or repeated violations will result in the revocation of parking privileges.
