IMMUNIZATIONS OFFERED

COVID-19 - For all ages 6 months and up

• 1st doses, 2nd doses, 3rd doses (for immunocompromised individuals), bivalent (omicron) boosters. Please note: Only Moderna will be offered for primary series. Both Moderna and Pfizer may be offered for bivalent boosters.

DTaP/Tdap - Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis

- Diphtheria: causes severe sore throat, difficulty breathing
- Tetanus: causes neurological problems, muscle stiffness
- Pertussis (Whooping Cough): causes severe cough, difficulty breathing

MMR - Measles, Mumps, Rubella

- Measles: causes fever, rash, pneumonia & meningitis
- Mumps: causes swelling of glands, meningitis
- Rubella: causes fever, rash



Hepatitis B - causes inflammation of the liver

Hib (Haemophilus influenzae B) - bacteria that causes sepsis (infection in blood), meningitis, swelling of throat, pneumonia

IPV - Inactivated Polio Vaccine

• Polio: causes neurologic problems and paralysis

Pneumococcal Vaccine (PCV13 - for children)

 Pneumococcal infection: A bacterial infection that can lead to pneumonia, blood poisoning (sepsis) and meningitis.

Meningococcal (MCV4 - for children)

• Meningococcal infection: causes meningitis, sepsis (infection in blood)

Rotarix - Rotavirus

• Rotavirus: causes severe diarrhea, dehydration in infants

Varicella - Chickenpox

Varicella: causes fever, rash
