

The MY Denver Card allows all school-age children living or attending school in the City and County of Denver free access to all Denver Recreation Centers. The card also can be used as their Denver Public Library card and provides great benefits at many Denver cultural venues.

Signing up is easy!

- Signing up for a MY Denver Card is easier than ever with the new, online application.
- Sign up in person at one of 24 <u>Denver recreation centers</u>.
- Parents of Denver Public Schools students may also opt their children into the MY Denver Card through the DPS enrollment process.
- Just signed up for your "first" MY Denver Card? Stop by one of our <u>Denver recreation centers</u> to take a photo and pick up your card, then your benefits will be activated. Cards are **not** mailed out.
- Already have a MY Denver Card? Stop by one of our <u>Denver recreation centers</u> to ensure your benefits are activated.

Cultural Facilities for Arts, Theater, Museums	Check with location before as benefits can change.
American Museum of Western Art	FREE admission to the Museum for up to 4 people. No children under 8 years old. FREE admission is valid for regular guided tours and self-guided tours. To reserve tickets please contact us here or call (303)293-2000.
Buffalo Bill	Free admission for the youth cardholder plus one accompanying adult.
Byers-Evans	General admission for kids ages 18 and under is always free at all History Colorado museums.
Clyfford Still	All youth 17 and under receive free admission. One adult accompanying a MY Denver Cardholders will also receive free general admission during all weekends and throughout winter, spring, and summer school breaks. Use discount code MyDenverCard during online checkout. Members must show the appropriate ID at the visitors desk to gain admission.
Denver Art Museum	All visitors 18 and under enjoy free general admission to the museum daily, ensuring that more children than ever can experience the transformative power of art.
Denver Botanic Gardens	Unlimited visits for MY Denver Card holders ages 5-18 and one accompanying adult during the months of January, February and March

Denver Center for the Performing Arts	Students may purchase up to two (2) advance tickets online for any Theatre Company show with promo code STUDENT at the following rates: \$20 tickets: Singleton Theatre: All performances in the Singleton Theatre Kilstrom and Wolf Theatres: All preview performances plus all weekday performances (Tues – Thurs) 15% off: Weekend performances (Fri – Sun) in the Kilstrom and Wolf Theatres, excluding preview performances
Denver Museum of Nature & Science	Permanent exhibitions and Museum entry are free
Denver Zoo	Denver Zoo provides youth cardholders (ages 5-18) free admission for themselves and one adult. This is good for unlimited visit to the Zoo and can be used year-round.
History Colorado Center	General admission for kids ages 18 and under is always free at all History Colorado museums.
Molly Brown House Museum	Children with a My Denver Card get free admission to the museum with an adult paying full price admission. This is valid Friday-Sunday all year, along with every day during Spring Break, Winter Break, and Summer Break. Use code MYDENVER during checkout. (Only valid for the Explore the Museum On Your Own tickets.)
Museum of Contemporary Art Denver	ALWAYS FREE PENNY SATURDAYS: Penny admission for the first Saturday of the month for Colorado residents
Museo de las Americas	Free for kids 13 and under. Additionally, we offer free admission every First Friday from 12-9pm, no tickets needed.
Southwest Rink at Skyline Park	Admission: FREE Bring your own skates or you can rent some from us! My Denver Cards Skate Rental: \$5
Cardholders can access any of Denver's 24 recreation centers.
