Dear Alburnett Families,

I trust this message finds you well and enjoying the warmer spurt of weather we are currently experiencing. Now that we are over halfway through the school year, it is always good to review things that were brought up during the beginning of the school year and a quick add on as well.

First, the add on. We have started to have some families entering the bus lane for either pickup or drop off. This is not safe for students as it interferes with the buses entering and leaving and is not allowed. I extended the bus lane marking on the image below with a purple arrow and the general prohibition symbol (the “do not” symbol) at both entrances so families know what is considered the bus lane and that it should not be entered.

Also, as a reminder, you can reference the attached image for how the traffic is intended to flow and the different pickup areas. We really appreciate the attention families are giving to make sure pickup and dropoff is as smooth as possible.

For informational purposes, we will have the parking lot striping and signage added either late this spring or over the summer. The company that Alburnett Schools has contracted with will let us know based on the weather. We will keep you updated as we continue this school year. Your patience while we wait on this work is greatly appreciated.
